



SHORT REPORT OF ACTIVITIES: 2024-25

Started in the year 1920 and affiliated to the Ramakrishna Mission, Belur Math in 1927, the Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Society conducted the following activities during the year 2024-25.

SPIRITUAL AND RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES

1. In the shrine attached to the monastery, daily worship of Bhagwan Sri Ramakrishna Deva, Holy Mother Sri Sarada Devi and Swami Vivekananda was performed.
2. After the evening Aratrikam readings from the lives of Sri Ramakrishna, Holy Mother and Swamiji, and also from Sri Sri Ramakrishna Kathamrita in Bengali and Hindi were held on all days in a week.
3. On every Ekadashi day, Ramanama Sankirtanam and on Purnima Tithi Shyamnam Sankirtanam were sung after the evening aratrikam.
4. All the major festivals, viz., birthday celebrations of Bhagwan Sri Ramakrishna Paramahansa Deva, Sri Sarada Devi and Swami Vivekananda, Shivaratri, Sri Sri Durga Puja, Sri Sri Kali Puja, Sri Sri Saraswati Puja, Christmas Eve, Buddha Purnima were observed with due solemnity and were attended by a large number of devotees.
5. Bhagawan Sri Ramakrishna Deva's Birthday was celebrated with special puja and Chandi Path on 1st March 2025, the Birthday Tithi of Sri Ramakrishna.
6. During the birth anniversaries of the direct disciples of Sri Ramakrishna, portions from their lives and teachings were read in the prayer hall after the evening Aratrikam.
7. Sri Sri Durga Puja was celebrated in image with due solemnity from 9th October 2024. Cooked Prasad was served to over 10,000 devotees who attended the Durga Puja.
8. Sri Sri Kali Puja was celebrated with due solemnity in image the Society premises on 31st October 2024 and Mahashivaratri was observed with special worship on 26th February 2025. Besides, Saraswati Puja in images was performed in all of our schools on 2nd February 2025.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

1. A Library and Reading Room with 8023 books.
2. Sixteen School Libraries with 78,046 books.
3. Singing of inspiring patriotic songs and speeches were organised in each of our schools by the students on Independence Day and Republic Day Celebrations.
4. National Youth Day was celebrated on 12th January 2025 by all the 16 schools under the Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Society, Jamshedpur.

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

The Society started its educational activities in early 1920s with just one school. Presently there are 16 schools run by the Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Society, Jamshedpur and it stands out as one of the big educational institutions of the entire Ramakrishna Mission.

The schools are making steady progress and attaining popularity due to sustained efforts of the teaching staff and the honorary workers. The schools and other educational activities run by the Ramakrishna Mission in Jamshedpur are as follows:

A. HIGH SCHOOLS: These are Hindi medium schools from **Standard VII to X** affiliated to Jharkhand Academic Council (JAC). We have the following High Schools in Jamshedpur:

1. **Vivekananda High School, Chenab Road:** Started in 1945, it was recognized in 1948 as a High School by the Board Secondary Education, Bihar. Only boys are admitted to this school. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 349 (previous year: 363).
2. **Saradmoni Girls' High School, Sakchi:** Started in 1951, it was recognized by the Board of Secondary Education, Bihar in 1954. This school is exclusively for girls. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 733 (previous year: 673).



3. **Sri Ramkrishna High School, Bistupur:** Started in 1949, it was recognized as a High School in 1953 by the Board of Secondary Education, Bihar. This school admits only boys. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 364 (previous year: 351).
4. **Sister Nivedita Girls' High School, Burmamines:** Started in 1951, it was recognized by the Board of Secondary Education, Bihar, in the same year. This is another High School for girls. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 626 (previous year: 669).
5. **Ramakrishna Mission Lady Indra Singh High School, Indranagar:** Started in 1958, this is a school for boys and girls in separate shifts. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 709 (previous year: 732).
- B. MIDDLE SCHOOLS:** We have the following Middle Schools in Jamshedpur: 3 of these are Hindi medium schools from Kindergarten to Standard VI and one English medium school affiliated to Jharkhand Academic Council (JAC).
 6. **Vivekananda Middle School, Bistupur:** A free night school for Harijans started in 1921, was developed into a Middle School in 1947 and was recognized in that year by the Department of Education, Bihar. Both boys and girls study in this school. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 439 (previous year: 439).
 7. **Vivekananda Middle School, Chenab Road, Sakchi:** Started as a Primary School in 1936, it was upgraded to Middle School and was recognized by the Department of Education, Bihar in 1944. Both boys and girls are studying in the school. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 860 (previous year: 860).
 8. **Vivekananda Middle School, Sidhgora:** Started in 1951 as an upper Primary School, it was upgraded to the status of Middle School in 1952. The Department of Education, Bihar, in the same year recognized it. This school admits boys and girls from Kindergarten to standard VIII. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 518 (previous year: 484).
 9. **Ramakrishna Mission Lady Indra Singh Middle School, Indranagar:** Started in 1957, this is a school with Hindi and Bengali medium classes for boys and girls in separate shifts. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 641 (previous year: 647).
- C. UPPER PRIMARY SCHOOL:**
 10. **Vivekananda Upper Primary School, Bhuiyadih:** Started in 1922 as a lower Primary School for Harijan students, the school was upgraded to Upper Primary School and was recognized by the Education Department, Bihar in 1951. Both boys and girls are studying in the school from Kindergarten to Standard V. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 143 (previous year: 150).
- D. ENGLISH MEDIUM SCHOOLS:**
 11. **Ramakrishna Mission English School, Sidhgora:** Started in 1979, it was affiliated to CBSE as a Secondary School in the year 1987; it was subsequently affiliated to CISCE New Delhi in 2003 as a Secondary School, and was upgraded as a Higher Secondary School in the year 2008. Both boys and girls are studying in the school up to Class XII. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 2193 (previous year: 2336).

The following 5 English Medium Schools under CISCE Board were started in the year 1993:
 12. **Ramakrishna Mission English School, Bistupur:** Started in 1993, this is a co-educational English Medium School from Nursery to Class X; it was affiliated to CISCE, New Delhi in the year 2003. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 2081 (previous year: 2159).
 13. **Sister Nivedita English High School, Burmamines:** Started in 1993, this is a co-educational English Medium School from Nursery to Class X; it was affiliated to CISCE, New Delhi in the year 2003. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 1109 (previous year: 1148).
 14. **Vivekananda English High School, Chenab Road, Sakchi:** Started in 1993, this is a co-educational English Medium School from Nursery to Class X; it was affiliated to CISCE, New Delhi in the year 1999. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 660 (previous year: 678).
 15. **Saradmoni English School, Sakchi:** Started in 1993, this is a co-educational English Medium Middle School from Nursery to Std. VIII, proposed to be affiliated to CISCE, New Delhi. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 253 (previous year: 276).
 16. **Ramakrishna Mission Lady Indra Singh English School, Indranagar:** This is a co-educational English Medium School from Nursery to Class X; it was affiliated to CISCE, New Delhi in the year 2016. During the year 2024-25 the Roll Strength was 521 (previous year: 492).

- E. Non-formal Coaching Centre:** One free non-formal school (coaching centre) is being run at Adityapur, in the outskirts of Jamshedpur, for slum children. The Roll strength during the year was 203 (previous year: 189).
- F. One Students' Home** at Sakchi (Phone No. 07277780707) is being run since 1925 exclusively for boys belonging to Backward, Harijan and Tribal communities of rural areas. During the year 2024-25 in the Hostel there were 120 boys (previous year: 120) out of which 75 boys from Tribal Community were maintained free of cost in all respects viz., boarding, educational expenses, medical treatment etc.

MEDICAL ACTIVITIES

- Free Medical Treatment is provided through our **Mobile Medical Unit** in the slum and interior areas of Adityapur, Kandra, Kuluptanga, Kudada and Patamda.
- Twelve **Free Eye camps** for Cataract Operation were organised during the year in collaboration with Purnima Netralaya, Jamshedpur. Intra-ocular lens (IOL) surgeries were performed on 360 patients and 328 of them were given spectacles free of cost. Each patient was given one woollen blanket.
- A **Blood Donation Camp** was organized in the Ashrama premises on National Youth Day, the 12 January 2025 in which 121 people donated blood voluntarily for this noble cause.
- Under the Pallimangal activities, charitable **Homeopathic Clinics** are run in the remote villages of East Singhbhum district. Clinics are held three days a week each at Paharpur, Boram and Metyala villages. During the year 2024-25, 6748 patients were treated through these clinics.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING

- A Typewriting Institute is run to teach typewriting in English and Hindi, free of cost, to tribal students of whom there were 2 boys 21 girls.
- A BCA course, affiliated to Kolhan University, Chaibasa was run at the at the Computer Centre, with only one girl student this year.
- A Computer Lab is also run in the premises where IGNOU-sponsored various courses are conducted. During the year, 239 students (163 boys and 76 girls) were trained.

WELFARE & RELIEF ACTIVITIES

On 16th March 2025 Narayana Seva was conducted in the slum areas of Adityapur as a part of Sri Ramakrishna Birth Anniversary Celebrations. On this occasion, about 1350 poor people, and slum dwellers, were fed sumptuously.

- Scholarships:** A sum of Rs. 2,20,000/- was disbursed as IDBI Scholarship among 30 needy students. An additional sum of Rs. Rs.78,00,000/- was disbursed as Infosys Foundation Scholarship among 520 Students. A further sum of Rs. 8,13,362/- was disbursed being school-fees of the poor & meritorious students studying in our 16 schools.
- Pecuniary and medical help** was extended to the needy on a regular basis by way of distribution of clothes, blankets, settling medical bills etc. on which a sum of Rs. 10,59,714/- was spent.
